Hope to see EVERYONE out on the 4th - please have a happy and safe Independence Day!

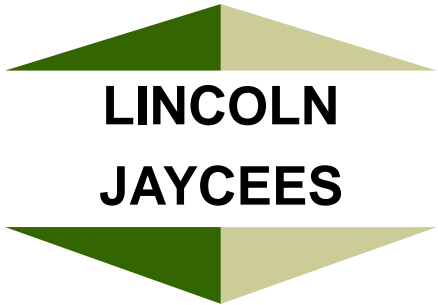

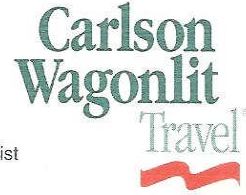
